Purpose

To give financial support to students majoring or showing a strong desire to major in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.

Criteria

Individual applicants must be full-time student from King William county enrolled in a college undergraduate or graduate level curriculum. Applicants shall document a class ranking in the top 20% of his/her graduating class or a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement. Applicants shall have an agricultural background or pursuing a college education to study agriculture, forestry or environmental science.

Selection will be based on scholastic ability, leadership qualities, financial need and educational goals.

Individual recipients of scholarships need to reapply for scholarship consideration in ensuing years.

Amount Given

A \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded. The check will be issued to the selected school in the student's name.
