Purpose

The Three Rivers SWCD scholarship program promotes the education of students in technical fields with a natural resource conservation and environmental protection emphasis. The program provides financial support to students with an agriculture background, majoring in or showing a strong desire to major in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.

Criteria

Individual applicants must be residents of King & Queen County who have applied to a college freshman level curriculum or full-time students pursuing an undergraduate or graduate level degree. Applicants shall document a class ranking in the top 20% of his or her graduating class or have a 3.0 or greater grade point average. The applicants' most recent official high school transcript must accompany the application. Copies will not be accepted.

Amount Given

A \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded. The check will be issued to the selected school in the student's name.
